CREATE A CHIC DISPLAY

When short on space, use your products as décor. Find a tray you love (consider something vintage) and put pretty packaging in view on your countertop, says Sara Eizen, a professional organizer in Seattle.

CORRAL YOUR SAMPLES

It's hard to resist trial sizes, but who can ever find them again? Keep your samples straight by banding them together in categories with color-coded binder clips, says Monica Ricci, an organizing pro in Atlanta. Or get in the habit of storing the packets in your travel case or gym bag so you have them on hand, says Eizen. Got a guest bathroom? Cultivate a spa atmosphere by filling a beautiful basket or jar with high-end samples.

MEDICINE CABINET

How many times have you opened the door only to be bombarded with a cavalcade of little bottles and tubes? Position supplies upright in simple cabinet dividers (like the one above) or Magna Pods, clear plastic shelves that magnetically attach to the inside of your cabinet's door (\$7-\$10/set of 3; magnapods.com).

SPACE UNDER THE SINK

"A lot of people don't make use of the area under the sink because they can't get at what's down there," says Target Style Expert for Home (and HGTV designer) Sabrina Soto. She recommends buying a graduated shelf or a two-tiered lazy Susan to make products you stash easier to see—and reach.

COUNTERTOP
