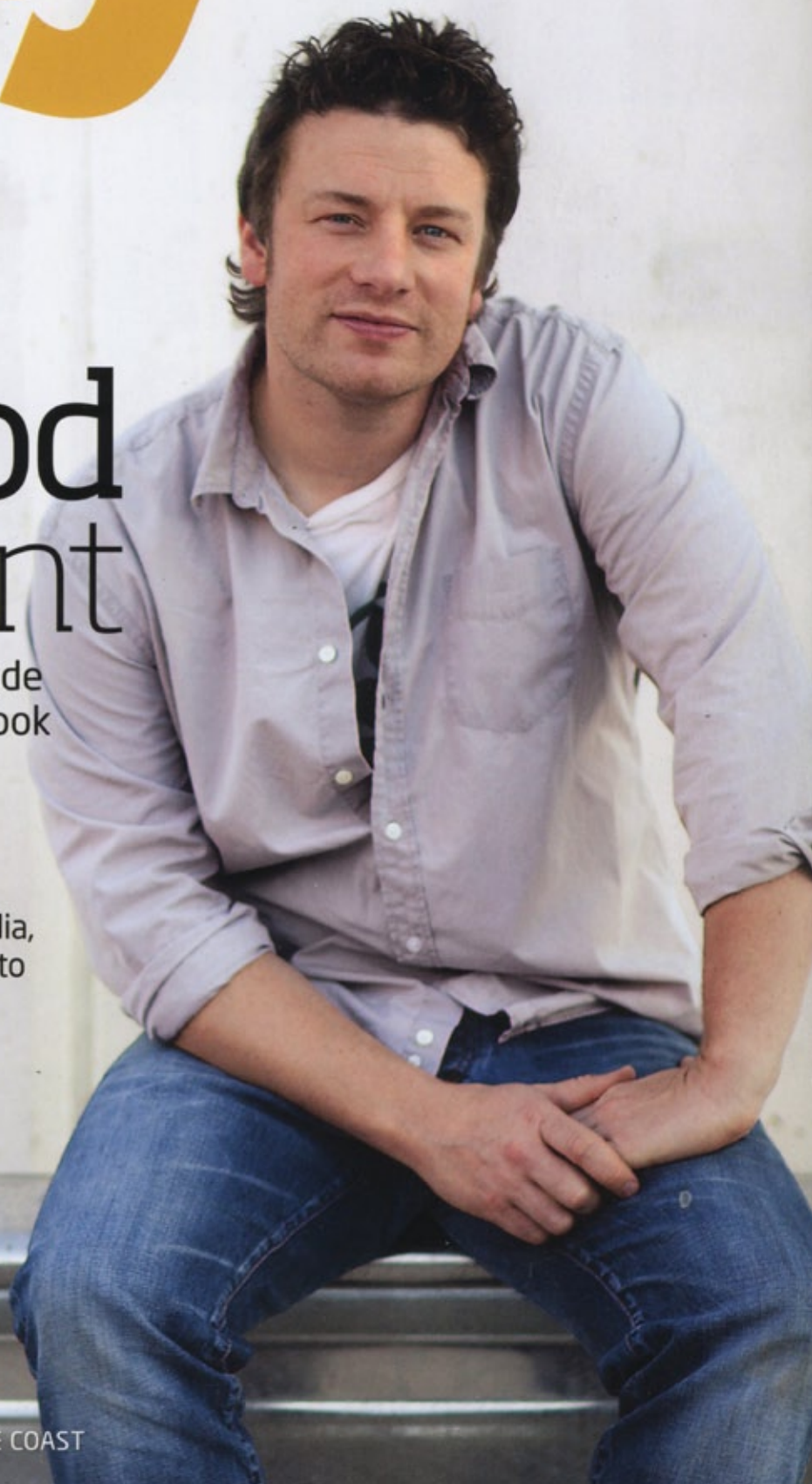

Beach Retreats

Savor the last days of summer at these coastal sanctuaries. By Jason Oliver Nixon

1 | Sveti Stefan, Montenegro // Tiny Montenegro has burst onto the international jet-set scene. Adding to the country's allure is the just-opened **Aman Sveti Stefan** resort, housed on a gemlike island in buildings dating back to the 1400s. Relax in your spacious suite before enjoying the beaches or lounging beside the dramatic swimming pool built into the cliffs. amanresorts.com

2 | Naples, Florida // Relax at **The Ritz-Carlton**, situated just outside of the eponymous beach town on Florida's west coast. Walk along white-sand strands or tackle the nearby Greg Norman-designed golf course. For dinner, try contemporary surf and turf (think veal cheeks and abalone). ritzcarlton.com/naples

3 | Atlantic City, New Jersey // If you seek a chic, Rat Pack-styled retreat in the heart of Atlantic City but without the teeming casino action, check into **The Chelsea**. The hotel exudes hipster style: After decompressing in your ocean-view room, have a Swedish massage before din-

ing on dry-aged New York strip steaks at **Chelsea Prime**. Later, dance under the stars at the rooftop **Cabana Lounge**. In the morning, head for groovy **Teplitzky's** and enjoy a comforting breakfast of diner fare. thechelsea-ac.com

4 | Oracabessa, Jamaica // Escape to a land where martinis are shaken not stirred at **Golden-Eye Hotel & Resort**, the former retreat of James Bond creator Ian Fleming. There is swimming, deep-sea fishing, scuba diving, birdwatching and more. Later, dine on fresh seafood and organic vegetables paired with owner Chris Blackwell's Blackwell Fine Jamaican rum. goldeneye.com

5 | Playa Maderas, Nicaragua // Spot animals—including monkeys—as you amble from your room at the **Aqua Wellness Resort** to the beach, yoga studio or surfing lesson. Outdoor Balinese showers and stunning ocean views round out the experience. Plus, dinner is served on the beach. aquanicaragua.com
