▶ John Derian

6 E 2nd St between Bowery and Second Ave (212-677-3917)

Derian is best known for his handmade decoupage plates and platters (\$48-\$2,200), but there's plenty of other ephemera to please design-minded folks here. You'll find glass paperweights emblazoned with images from nature (\$30), marbled-looking printed canvas totes (\$28), Moroccan leather poufs (\$295) and colorful paper-and-glass candleholders handmade in Paris (\$30).

▶ A&G Merch

111 North 6th St at Berry St, Williamsburg, Brooklyn (718-388-1779, aandgmerch.com)

This store has the same edgy feel as its big brother, avant-furniture gallery Future Perfect, but boasts much kinder price points. Some of the unconventional home accents include corked EAST RIVER glass bottles (\$19), realistic green-apple candles (\$7), lightbulb-shaped salt and pepper shakers (\$23), hand-carved wooden owl-shaped bottle openers (\$25) and custom-order oversize red carnival lights (\$229) that would brighten anyone's holiday party.

▶ Spring

126A Front St between Jay and Pearl Sts, Dumbo, Brooklyn (718-222-1054, spring3d.net)

Operating as half gallery, half retail shop, Spring features well-designed housewares curated by a rotating host of artists and designers. The store's offerings include Artecna glass and tableware (\$45-\$68) made from hand-cut recycled wine and beer bottles, custom silhouette portraits by Brooklyn artist Molly Dilworth (\$150) and the Dandelight, a delicate lamp with real dandelion seeds individually attached to an LED bulb (\$120).
