WARMING TRENDS

A LITTLE ON THE SIDE

Flanking a bed, set beside a sofa or tucked between chairs, side tables punctuate rooms with character and convenience. The trick is knowing how to choose and use them.

SIZE

Get the right fit.

The height of the table should be roughly the same as that of the mattress, sofa or chair arm that it flanks, to make reaching its surface comfortable. Err on the side of choosing something a touch too low and small as opposed to anything too high or big.

QUANTITY

How many end tables?

Well, how many spots to sit do you have in the room? Every seat should have a table close-at-hand to set down a drink or book (without stretching to reach a coffee table or walking to a nearby console). Key spots include the sofa's ends, beside or between chairs and, of course, at the bed's sides.

STYLE

Matching? No.

Complementary? Yes.

Mix it up, but use a common characteristic to avoid a hodgepodge look. For example, if you have tables featuring different materials, choose comparable shapes; if the styles vary, select similar materials. If the sizes, shapes, styles or materials relate, the mix will work.
